Those drawing the odd numbers shall serve for the term of two years, those drawing the even numbers shall serve for the term of four years, so that thereafter one half of the Senators, shall be elected every two years, and in case of an increase of the number of senators, the same proceeding shall be had to determine the long and short terms of the senators first elected from the new districts.

Sec. 15. The legislative assembly shall in the year 1835, and every ten years thereafter, cause an enumeration to be made of the population of the state.

Sec. 16. The number of representatives shall, at the next session following the enumeration of the inhabitants by the United States or this state be fixed by law and apportioned among the several counties according to the population, exclusive of persons not eligible to become citizens of the United States. And the ratio of the representatives shall be determined by dividing the whole number of the population by the number of representatives; and the number of representatives of which any County or district shall be entitled shall be determined by dividing the whole number of ~~the~~ population of such County or district by such representative ratio; and when a fraction shall result, ~~the said ratio~~ <sup>the ratio of population</sup> such county or district shall be entitled to a member for such fraction; and in case any county shall not have the requisite <sup>entire</sup> population to entitle such county to a member, then such county shall be attached to some adjoining county or counties for representative purposes.

Sec. 17. A representative district when more than one county ~~shall~~ shall constitute the same, shall be composed of contiguous counties, and no county shall be divided in creating such districts.
