Added Section 23.

"Provided that whenever any member of the Legislature shall travel on a passport in coming to or returning from a session of the Legislature the number of miles actually traveled on such pass shall be deducted from the mileage of such member."

2 ties of their respective offices, take or subscribe the following oath or affirmation: "I do
