How are lives commemorated; how can victims grieve and perpetrators demonstrate remorse. Timing, guilt.

Role of Truth Commissions in other societies. Prisoners - what are the issues, what might our position be.

# Policing

Not to look so much to policing - societies, but to policing societies which have large deprived areas, how police force became accepted, or attempted to serve the law as opposed to enforce it.
