















The New Northern Ireland Assembly

The New Northern Ireland Assembly was established as part of the Belfast Agreement reached at the multi-party negotiations on Friday 10 April, now commonly referred to as the 'Good Friday Agreement'

Following a referendum held on 22 May 1998 which resulted in a majority voting in favour of the agreement the New Northern Ireland Assembly was constituted under the Northern Ireland

108 members were elected to the Assembly on 25 June 1998 by Proportional Representation (Single Transferable Vote) from the existing 18 Westminster constituencies.

Lord Alderdice was appointed as the initial Presiding Officer of the New Northern Ireland Assembly by the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland, Dr Marjorie Mowlam, MP and will remain in office until a member is elected as Presiding Officer by the Assembly.
